

California Proposition 65 Label Placement Instruction

The California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) amended regulations related to "clear and reasonable" Proposition 65 warnings ("Warning") went into effect August 30, 2018. For McElroy machines which are sold into and/or operated within California, the included label must be attached to the machine at the location specified below.

The purpose of Proposition 65 is to ensure the public is informed about potential exposures to chemicals which the state of California has determined can cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. The list now includes more than 900 chemicals. McElroy machines may contain trace amounts of listed compounds as a result of our manufacturing processes and materials.


